Interested students are encouraged to review the details and submit their applications by the given deadline. The details are given below:

Undergraduate and postgraduate students and research scholars enrolled in recognized universities or institutions in India and abroad can apply for the India Space Lab Internship. Participants will work closely with various verticals, divisions, and cells of Space and receive training in Drone Technology (Air Taxi), CanSat and CubeSat (Student Satellite), Space Entrepreneurship, and Astronomy.

Applicants must apply online by completing the registration form.

About The Internship:

The winter internship has a total of 845 available seats. Selection shall be conducted on a merit basis, determined by the candidate's performance and marks attained in the Examination.

Registration for the winter internship and training program will open on October 25th at 3 PM. The online application link is open from **25**th **October – 22**nd **November** till 5pm.

Shift 1: Exam Date: 30th November at 2pm to 3:30pm Shift 2: Exam Date: 1st December at 2pm to 3:30pm

Application fees may apply: ₹750.

Students with an annual family income of INR 8 lakh to 10 lakh Application fees may apply: ₹350

The exam will be based on Intermediate Mathematics and Logical Reasoning. It will consist of 35 questions; each question will carry two marks and total duration of the exam is 1 hour 30 min.

Note: The results will be announced on December 5th, and training will commence on December 7th. Both the exam and training will be conducted online.
