Annexure: Frequently Asked Questions:

Q1: Can I still apply for other scholarships?

A1: There are no restrictions from for applicants on applying for or accepting any other scholarship or fee waiver offered by the University, Government, or any private organizations. However, we want to make it clear that if you are selected as a Dell Aspire Scholar and subsequently receive another scholarship, particularly a government scholarship that prohibits recipients from accepting additional financial aid, the selected candidates would have the flexibility to choose to accept or not accept the Dell Aspire Scholarship.

Q2: When will the Dell Aspire Scholars program Start?

A2: The scholarship will commence from the second semester and continue up to your final semester if you meet the program's eligibility criteria. It is likely to start from February or March 2024.

Q3: What types of financial and non-financial support are included as components of the Dell Aspire Scholars program?

A3: The Dell Aspire Scholarship includes the following:

- Partial College Fee: Rs 30,000 Per Semester (Total: Rs 2,10,000 over 7 Semesters)
- Partial Accommodation: Rs 40,000 Per Semester (Up to: Rs 2,80,000 for 7 Semesters)
All scholars staying in the college hostel or college-approved private hostel are eligible for this amount.
- Laptop: A premium quality laptop to support your academic work.
- Upskilling and Mentoring: Selected scholars will receive training and skilling support from industry experts to prepare them for college placements.

Q4: How can I reach out to your team if I have questions or require assistance?

A4: For any assistance during this process, reach out to apply.DTU@dellaspirescholars.org or contact us via WhatsApp at (+91 8448896206). You can also visit the Dell Aspire Scholarship Help Desk or the window number 6 in the college admin block.

Q5: If I have limited access to technology, is there assistance available to help me complete my application?

A5: Computers are reserved for applicants in the computer centre during college working hours. Please visit the computer centre above the Training and Placement (T&P) department.

Q6: Will there be a written test? What are the key factors that can make my scholarship application stand out?

A6: No, there will be no written test. The application form is designed to get to know you better as a student and aspirant. Be authentic and honest while filling out the application form. Think about your college goals and career aspirations.

Q7: What documents should I have ready throughout the entire application process?

A7: There are no documents required during the application process. You may be asked to present income proof later in the process.

Q8: What steps should I take to prepare for the interview as part of the application process?

A8: Block 2 hours of time and try to complete your application before the deadline.

Q9: When is the closing date for the scholarship application form?

A9: The application portal will close at midnight on October 8, 2023.
